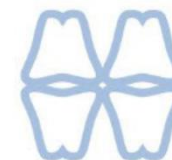

The West Kootenay Community TEETH Clinic Society believes all people deserve access to dental care. We endeavor to make dental care more affordable.

WK Community TEETH Clinic Society is a not-for-profit program offering high quality dental care for West Kootenay/ Boundary low income community members, children, their families and seniors.

All community members with a net family income of less than \$42,000 adjusted and 3 months of residency are eligible for dental services at the clinic.

The clinic accepts all government dental benefit insurance plans including:

Healthy Kids,  
First Nations Health Benefits,  
private dental plans,  
and people receiving Income Assistance.

### **No Dental Insurance or Benefits ??**

The clinic offers qualified residents without dental insurance or benefits and an annual income of less than \$42,000, a **reduction of approximately 40% off dental procedural costs found in the BC Dental Fee Guide. This is not a free program.**

**Fees for dental procedures must be paid on completion of treatment.**

### **LATE FEES**

(Many folks are waiting for their turn.)

**There is a no show & late cancellation fee of \$25.00 if less than 48 hours notice is given that must be paid before another appointment will be booked. Also, to book another appointment a further deposit of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of the estimated cost for the next treatment to a maximum of \$50.00 is required. For Ministry insurance patients that deposit is \$25.00**



West Kootenay Community TEETH Clinic Society partners with the community dental clinics of Dr. Fox of Cedar Avenue Dental in Trail, and Dr. Singer in Castlegar.

And general dentists, Dr. Audet, Dr. Day, Dr. Parrott, and Dr. Young also offer their services as does Record Ridge Denture Clinic
